Thank you for signing up for the **Run in the Park in Honor of Riki Jacobs**. This is the first year of what we hope will be an annual event, and we appreciate your enthusiasm, support and participation! The response so far has been remarkable.

REGISTRATION/PICK-UP: Your race materials will be available on Saturday, May 16, from Noon to 2:00 p.m. and again before the race on Sunday, May 17 beginning at 7:30 a.m.

On Saturday, come to the Main Street Highland Park office, 421 Raritan (across from Stop & Shop), from noon to 2:00 p.m. to pick up your materials.

On Sunday, registration/pick up takes place beginning at 7:30 a.m. in the parking lot behind Bank of America, next to Studio @ 808, at the corner of N 8th and Raritan Avenues.

The race begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. from 8th Avenue North, directly across the street from the parking lot where you pick up your race number and t-shirt. The race route can be downloaded by visiting the Main Street Highland Park web site (www.MainStreetHP.org) and clicking on "race route" under the Announcements section. Raritan Avenue will close to traffic at 9:00 a.m. and the race will begin moments later. Vendors for the Street Fair, who will be setting up in the street will wait until the race clears the street, and then they will move in. The race will end on the track at the High School.

PARKING: There is abundant street parking but please plan ahead. Highland Park residents should plan on walking to the race. Click [here](#) for Google maps.

BATHROOMS. Bathrooms will be available at the start of the race at the registration area inside Studio @ 808; bathrooms will also be available at the end of the race in the High School.

Lastly, we would like to encourage those who are able to do so, to pick up their materials on Saturday, between noon and 2:00 p.m.; and if you know anyone else who would like to run please tell them that it will be much easier for them to pre-register.
